## God's Day (Bilingual)

[4:28] This is a way of asking for the Pharisees that the Pharisees didn't have any questions And this form of answer led to the Pharisees being unable to answer his question. The second method is that Jesus directly teaches him In this teaching we see the Pharisees in the Bible There are two main points And in his teaching there are two main points First, the Sabbath was made for man and man was not made for the Sabbath This is similar to the first method of cancer questioning.

It talks about the relationship between the Lord and people. People are more important than the Lord because they are the Lord that they serve people.

Jesus is challenging the law activists.

Because these people have turned the laws that were originally meant to serve people into heavy burdens.

Jesus did not deny the importance of the Sabbath. But he wanted to take the opportunity to correct the understanding people had about the Sabbath.

**EXAMPLE 1** In Mark's Gospel, healing miracles are a symbol of truth that Jesus is condemned.

So through his actions, he reveals his identity of being God's Son, and also reveals his role as the Lord of the Sabbath. So what is the end result of Jesus' teachings and actions about the Sabbath?

Let's look at the 6th verse. The following message is that the Pharisees went out and immediately met up with the Herodians to discuss how to deal with Jesus.

[10:37] Let's get rid of it. It's a very simple and direct passage. So when we have understood this passage, how do we use this in our daily lives?

In order to use the teachings in the Gospel, we must first find something to hold in three verses.

You can usually find these in the words of Jesus.

In the Bible, the very important thing is that the Sabbath was created for men, and men were created for the Sabbath.

I think this principle is not only agreeable to Christians. Even in other religions, such as Islam or Jew or Judaism, or even people of no religion would be in favor of having a Sabbath.

[12:18] Anyone here who do not want a rest day and wants to live seven days to live?

Okay. People need yes, and it's a way of love. And it's for the good of the future that we have a rest day every week.

So I think many people are waiting for the Sabbath. That's why many people from Mondays anticipate the routine.

I don't have your time. I don't have your time. They're indifferent. I usually from the week of the week. Then you usually face the weekend from Friday.

If you say it's the rest day and Thursday. We all hope that it's the rest day. Everyone hates the Lord yesterday. Because that day they don't have to go to work or go to school to school.

[13:39] Jesus used the example of David to show that only under emergency situation, and for the sake of helping others, only them can break the Lord.

No matter what day you make your Sabbath to be, you can always say that this Saturday is made for you.

Other days you'll be living for your boss or living to go to school.

[15:14] But on the Sabbath, you can live for yourself. On this day, you can do anything you want.

If you have this kind of thinking, then even if you are a Christian, then you can easily conform to the modern Western society secularized version of Sunday.

So, if you are a Christian, then at most you'll be two hours every Sunday to go to church, and then they'll rest the time with you work.

But Jesus teaches us that the Sabbath is not only for us to live.

But it is more the Lord's day. If you have read Genesis, then you'll see that in chapter 2, when God had completed all His work, He stopped all or were from the seventh time.

[16:48] And we blessed that day and took him with everything. We must go to the Sabbath day.

But this day is not for us to live. It is for the Lord's day. The Sabbath that we observe is not bad. It's not bad. But do you keep in mind that being a Christian is not only for Sundays, but we are living for Jesus every day.

But on the Sabbath, you must take extra care to put everything aside and only be with God.

So, the Sabbath is not for you to go watch movies or go shopping.
