[8 : 07] The first point is that The child can be used by Christ Here is a boy The word boy in ancient Greek is *paidarion* Which can be translated roughly as Young person Or more accurately as A young servant So it might not just be a child It could talk about any one of us here My beloved brothers and sisters You may have ever thought of why that boy just so happened to be present near the sea of Galilee that day He just happened to be at the right place At the right time For the right purpose To be an instrument for God

How do we interpret this? We may have a second. There are two ways. Firstly, the boy was willing to seek Christ. There is a boy. The story doesn't tell us what it was that caused the boy to follow the crowds. Maybe he had parents who had faith in Jesus. Maybe his parents encouraged him to go see Christ. Or perhaps. Or maybe he heard Christ's many miracles. So he followed the crowds. So he followed the crowds. And hence followed the crowds in order to see another miracle. This is our only.
